

Water policy

Water is precious. This is becoming increasingly clear now that we regularly have to deal with periods of drought in Belgium. Drinking water supplies are not infinite and a sustainable approach is needed to ensure good water quality and quantity for everyone in the same watershed as our production sites.

To ensure this sustainable approach, we at CCEP Belgium will implement and maintain a water stewardship program in line with the “Alliance for Water Stewardship” (AWS) standard, which is part of our overall sustainability action plan “THIS IS FORWARD”. Through AWS we will strive to continuously make our water use more sustainable and to minimize our impact throughout the whole value chain by promoting the use of fresh water in a socially, economically and environmentally beneficial way to our stakeholders.

The stewardship program aims to go beyond what is legally required, focusing on continuous improvement in 5 key areas: (1) Good Water Governance, (2) Sustainable Water Balance, (3) Good Water Quality Status, (4) Important Water-related Areas & (5) Safe Water Sanitation and hygiene for All.
