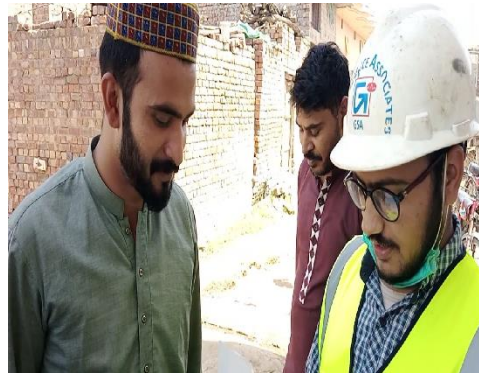

- What is the situation of drinking water supply infrastructure (Water filtration Plants)?
- What is the condition of wastewater infrastructure/ drainage system in the area?

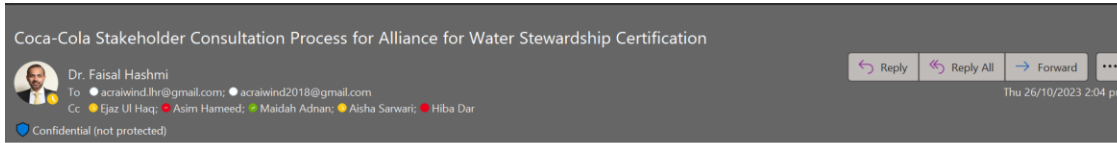


Meeting with Secretary Environment Protection Department (EPD Punjab)

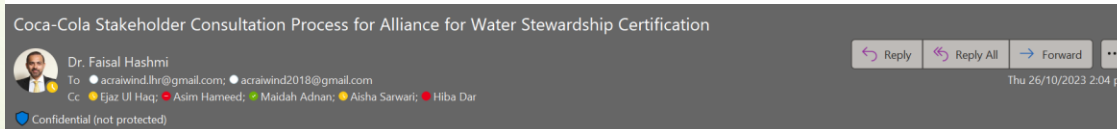

You are requested to please depute a liaison officer to coordinate and assist us in implementing above activities at an early date.

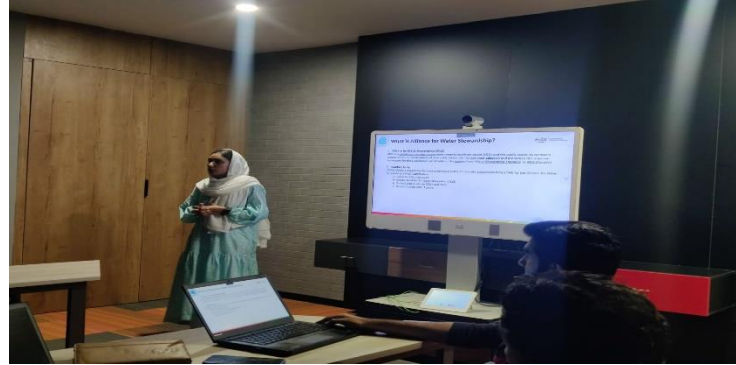
